September 25-29 is Suicide Prevention Awareness Week at Gray Stone Middle. Our theme is



IIII NC Check-Ins 2.0- September 27-October 11

NC Check-Ins 2.0 are interim assessments aligned to North Carolina grade-level content standards developed by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI). The main purpose of NC Check-Ins is to provide students, teachers, parents, and stakeholders with immediate in-depth action-data and a reliable estimate of students' current performance on the selected sub-set of content standards.

Please remember that **this is not a graded assessment**. It is truly an opportunity to collect data for instructional purposes. **However**, it is vital for our students to consider it an important assessment and they should try to

answer all questions to the best of their **ability**. If we are going to use instructional time to assess students so that we can better meet their needs academically, then they must participate to their fullest potential in order for us to ensure we are collecting valid information.

NC Check In window will begin for our students September 28 and 29 for all grade levels in Math. Reading check in will be October 10 and 11. Teachers will send a "remind message" concerning dates for these assessments.

Procedures for Reserving the Wall

The following rules shall apply:

- 1. The Spirit Wall may be reserved for 2 consecutive calendar days for \$10. Reservations & payment should be made online at graystoneday.org > Parents.
- Gray Stone reserves the right to block dates for school use.
- 3. Families must furnish their own labor, paint and supplies.
 Only the Spirit Wall may be painted. Please take care not to damage the surrounding area, and pick up all trash after painting. Please be kind to our environment and recycle your empty cans.
- 4. NO profane words, symbols or any derogatory or offensive messages will be permitted on the Spirit Wall. No political or religious messages may be painted on the Spirit Wall. Gray Stone reserves the right to remove any content, message, or language from the Spirit Wall as deemed inappropriate or controversial at the sole discretion of the Gray Stone Day School Administration.
- 5. The family painting the wall assumes liability for any individual or member of the group who may be injured, or who may incur clothing or other personal property damage.

The Gray Stone Day School Spirit Wall is governed by the Honor Code, with the hopes that everyone will respect these guidelines.
