<u> CAR RIDER LINE:</u>

We are noticing a few minor issues in the car rider lines that we want to remind everyone to try to follow. Please note all of these are for the safety of our students and drivers along with the efficiency of the car rider line.

- 1. Be attentive to the staff member(s) directing traffic. They control the crosswalks and traffic flow.
- 2. When your car stops at any point between the two crosswalks between the buildings, that is the time to unload. Do not wait until you reach the head of the line.
- 3. Be prepared to unload as soon as your car stops.
- 4. Do not cross at any point except the crosswalk.
- 5. Do not use the middle school lane for any reason before 8:00 am
- 6. If no staff member is present, follow the Yield sign.
- 7. Do not exceed 10 mph when driving around the building, especially when students are visible.

Thank you all for your help with these points. For the most part, our drop off and pick up is running really well. We want to make sure that drop off and pickup continue as smoothly as possible and that no one is injured and no cars damaged.


